How to Make Icons from These Photos

1. Go to <u>www.agape-biblia.org/African-Saints/</u> (note the capital letters!) and select the photos you want to use, or download the entire folder of 30 photos.

2. Buy a packet of 8.5" x 11" photo paper.

3. Using a ruler, measure two pieces of the photo paper at 4" x 6" and one piece as 5" x 7" - OR - two pieces at 5" x 7".

4. Cut these pieces apart using an Exacto knife or other VERY SHARP knife on a cutting board so you don't scratch your desk or table.

6. Make & save custom printing profiles on your printer for $4" \times 6"$ and $5" \times 7"$ PHOTO QUALITY printing so you don't have to set it this way every time.

6. Set the printer's paper tray to the correct dimensions of the pieces of photo paper you've cut; put in a piece ONE AT A TIME to avoid misfeeds.

7. Using one of your custom print settings, print the photos that you've selected.

8. Take one printed photo of each size to a Dollar Tree store, hold a photo over various \$1.25 picture frames to select frames that don't block out the saints' names.

9. At your workspace, take out the glass from each picture frame and place it over the photo on your cutting board to cut off any excess edges.

10. Ask your priest to consecrate these framed photos so that they become holy icons. Then share them!

How to Make Icons from These Photos
