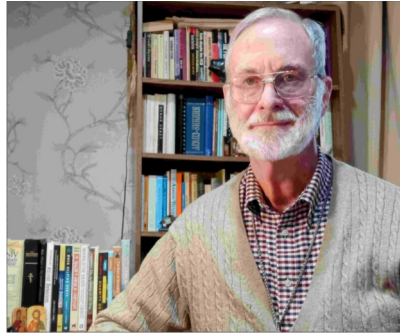


## About the author:

Dr. Robert D. Hosken, involved in missions for over 40 years, was raised in a middle class family, a middle child among an older brother and four sisters. His mother's family descends from Edward Doty who came to the New World on the Mayflower in 1620. Edward wasn't one of the Pilgrims originally, he was an indentured servant who belonged to Stephen Hopkins, one of the Pilgrims. So Robert



is the descendant of a "white slave." On the way across the ocean, the Pilgrims decided they shouldn't allow slavery in the New World, so they freed all their slaves. Thus began the anti-slavery movement: Edward Doty, a slave, became one of the Pilgrims and signed the Mayflower Compact, the first government document in America. Another descendant of Edward Doty is Roger Sherman, the only person who signed all four founding documents of the United States. One of Sherman's descendants is Civil War General William Tecumseh Sherman, and other Doty's descendants include Civil War General Ulysses S. Grant and Susan B. Anthony, Robert's great-great-aunt. So freedom from slavery and oppression of human rights runs deep in Robert's lineage.

He has been a student of Russian and Central European affairs since 1961, has a diploma as a Russian interpreter, B.A. in Central and East European Studies, has been actively working for freedom of religious expression, having translated several documents and books by Soviet dissidents. He is fluent in Russian and German, has studied French, Spanish, Greek, Hungarian, Udmurt, Mari and Ukrainian, has a two-year technical college diploma in IT, knows over twenty computer languages and has about thirty-five years of experience developing computer software concurrently with working for freedom in the former Soviet empire. Over the years he has written, translated or edited ten books in five languages, and while living in Russia from 1991 to 2007 he served as General Editor of Agape-Biblia - [www.Agape-Biblia.org](http://www.Agape-Biblia.org) a revision of the standard Russian Synodal Translation and the first hypertext Russian Bible for Windows OS, now in its second print edition. 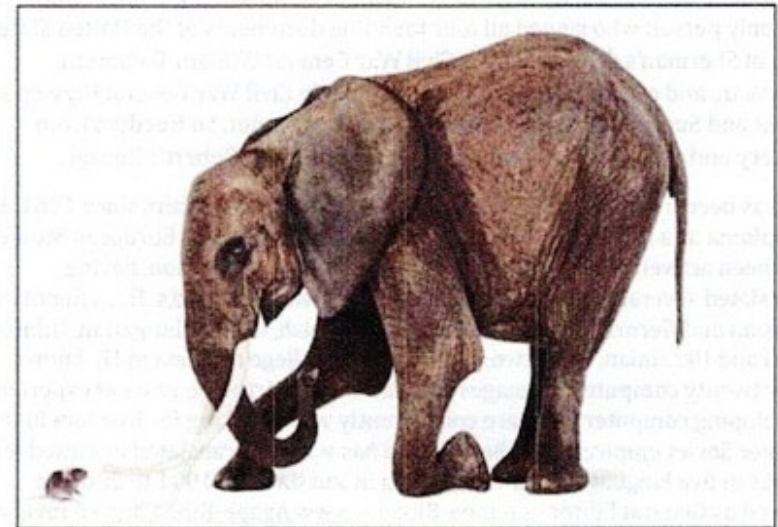
